Weekly Theme: New Year; snow; winter

This Week:



Reading: I will be going over books with each group at guided reading. These books should be on your child's level so they should be able to read them to you independently. They may need a reminder to sound out the words. Please make sure they read & retell them to you. They should also have a library book. If they have time they may read it too. Please remember to sign your child's reading log in their red homework folder. They should be reading around 10 to 15 minutes a night. If your child forgets their book you can have them practice their word list. Your child will be working in class on phonics, spelling, and writing work stations. We are focusing beginning consonant blends, ending consonant blends, & reading word list B during the 2nd trimester.



Math: We will start our first topic over subtraction today.



Phonics/Spelling: Phonics & spelling are done in class. This week we are working on new heart words: may, no, now, came, & out. We will also work on words with blends. Our word wall words are fly, try, why, play, & today. If your child has a set of sight words in their folder please make sure they read them to you each night.



Grammar/Writing: We will be writing in our journals. We will complete some directive drawings & write about them. We will write about our Christmas break.
